Information for your Pediatrician

There is a growing need in Fort Wayne for autism evaluations and long wait lists have parents waiting several months to years for a confirmed diagnosis. Because of this, many children are potentially missing out on crucial early intervention services. Board certified speech language pathologists, Mary Richardson and Brittany Hursh, are offering the service of autism evaluations to help parents on their journey.

Mary and Brittany have extensive backgrounds in working with children with autism and are specially trained in administration and interpretation of the ADOS-2 and are offering an opportunity for pediatricians and family physicians to refer families of children 18 months to 6 years for autism evaluations.

The evaluation would include administration of:

- Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule - 2nd edition (ADOS-2)
- Childhood Autism Rating Scale - 2nd edition (CARS-2)
- Receptive/expressive language screener (PLS-5 or The Rossetti Infant-Toddler Rating Scale)
- Informal observations from during the evaluation

A comprehensive report with scores, interpretations, and recommendations would be faxed to the referring physician for a confirmation of diagnosis. A copy would also be provided to parents.
